NORTHERN MARKET REPORT

Sales were held in Melbourne and Fremantle and the final specialty fine wool sale for 2004 was held in Newcastle this week.

Sales opened in Newcastle on Tuesday and there was good competition for spinners with prices achieving prices similar to the last Newcastle sale. Best style skirtings were keenly sought after and prices were 5-10c/kg clean dearer compared to last week's Sydney sale. Crossbred fleece prices were firm and oddments were generally unchanged.

The offering was mainly Best to Good style on Wednesday, in the 17-20 micron range. Spinners continued to receive strong support and were firmer again, while 40-50 nkt lots were around 2% dearer. 18-19 microns were around 1% dearer while 20-22 microns were unchanged. Best style skirtings were 1% dearer while others were unchanged, oddments were also unchanged.

On Thursday the small offering of spinners types were firm, however the Best style 45nkt 16-18 micron lots were around 15c/kg clean cheaper. 19 micron and broader fleeces were generally unchnaged. Skirtings, crossbreds and oddments saw very little changed in prices.

The Australian dollar reached 79c US on Monday and there were concerns early in the week that the market would open cheaper again. However negative economic data for Australia saw the dollar dropped back below 78c US early on Tuesday and this seemed to help stabilise prices and stimulate some buying interest. The fast approaching Christmas recess is another factor that may have helped prices stabilise this week. With only one more sale in Melbourne and Fremantle and two more sales in Sydney, buyers are running out of opportunities to fill January orders before the recess. Next week sales continue in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle.


