NORTHERN MARKET REPORT

There was a three-day aucton sale in Melbourne this week with two-day sales held in Sydney and Femantle. This week's national offering of approximately 63,000 bales was the largest offering since August last year.


The market opened softer in Melbourne on Tuesday with nearly all microns recording falls of 1-3c/kg clean. 22 microns were 4c/kg clean dearer and crossbreds were also 1-4c/kg clean dearer. Skirtings and oddments were generally unchanged. Passed-in rate of 8%.

The finer end was stronger when sales opened in Sydney on Wednesday, mainly on the back of the better style, 40nkt+ lots which saw prices rise around 5-10c/kg clean. The mid microns and crossbreds were a touch cheaper with prices falling around 1-2c/kg clean. Skirtings and oddments were again generally unchanged, although the longer and better style skirtings were in good demand.

The market opened firm on Thrusday, however prices drifted over the sale due in most part to a less stylish offering. Most microns saw prices fall 5-10c/kg clean, while crossbreds were generally unchanged. Merino skirtings were generally uncahnged while there was good demand for oddments pushing prices up around 5c/kg clean on Thursday. Passed-in rates for the week averaged around 8-9%.

The projected national offering next week is lower with approximately 53,000 bales. Two-day sales continue in Sydney and Fremantle next week. There are no Melbourne sales with a three-day specialty sale being held in Launceston next week.






