#### NORTHERN REGION MARKET REPORT -


Auction sales were held in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week. The national offering was slightly higher this week with approximately 67,000 bales on offer. The market continued to show signs of improvement this week, particularly given that the offering was slightly higher than last week. Sales opened in Sydney on Tuesday and prices were generally unchanged in comparison to the more stylish offering in Newcastle last week. The only exceptions being 26 micron fleece down 16c/kg clean and merino skirtings which were down 5-10c/kg clean. On Wednesday 19 micron and finer fleece prices were up 5c/kg clean and crossbred fleeces were up 5-10c/kg clean while the remainder was generally unchanged. On Wednesday the Australian dollar rose sharply against the US dollar with the announcement by the Reserve Bank that interest rates would rise aonther 0.25%. It is encouraging to note that prices were generally firmer despite the strengthing dollar. The dollar closed just above 73c US on Wednesday, a six-year high. This indicates that demand may be starting to strengthen as the Christmas recess approaches. Merino skirtings and crossbred fleece prices were both around 5-10c/kg clean dearer on Wednesday.

Prices were generally firmer again on Thursday with finer merino fleece prices up 5c/kg clean and broader crossbred fleeces up 5-10c/kg clean. Merino skirtings were up 10-20c/kg clean on Thursday.

This week's prices for mid to broader merino fleece wool continue to remain at high levels in historic terms, while demand for finer wool seems to remain low resulting in relatively lower prices for 19 micron and finer fleece wool in comparison to the long term average.

Sales continue next week in Sydney Melbourne and Fremantle before a three week recess over Christmas.


