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MARKET COMMENTARY Source: AWI

The wool market recorded an overall rise for the second consecutive series. The national offering was smaller than the 44,257 bales originally rostered due in part to 6.1% of the offering being withdrawn prior to sale, leaving only 38,838 bales on offer.

With FNF (<1% VMB) fleece wool continuing to become less available, these types attracted the strongest buyer attention, so much so that in some cases, buyers were willing to overlook some shortcomings in order to secure quantity of these low VM types. Demand for this wool was the driving force behind the overall increase in the market and in the rises that were recorded in some of the Individual MPGs (the overall movements for the MPGs ranged between -8 and +53 cents nationally).

Merino skirtings followed a similar path to the fleece, with lower vm types highly sought after, while the crossbred sector was generally unchanged compared to the previous week. On the back of these movements, the EMI gained 8 cents for the week, closing at 1,310 cents. For the first time in six selling weeks, the EMI recorded an increase in US dollar terms, by gaining 13 US cents for the series (to close at 874 US cents).

The oddments were the poorest performing sector this week. The three Merino Carding Indicators fell by an average of 9 cents, mainly caused by a general reduction of 20 cents in locks carrying more than 3% vm. These losses prevented the EMI from a larger rise.

Next week's offering is forecast to rise, there are currently 48,643 bales on offer, with selling to be held on Tuesday and Wednesday only.

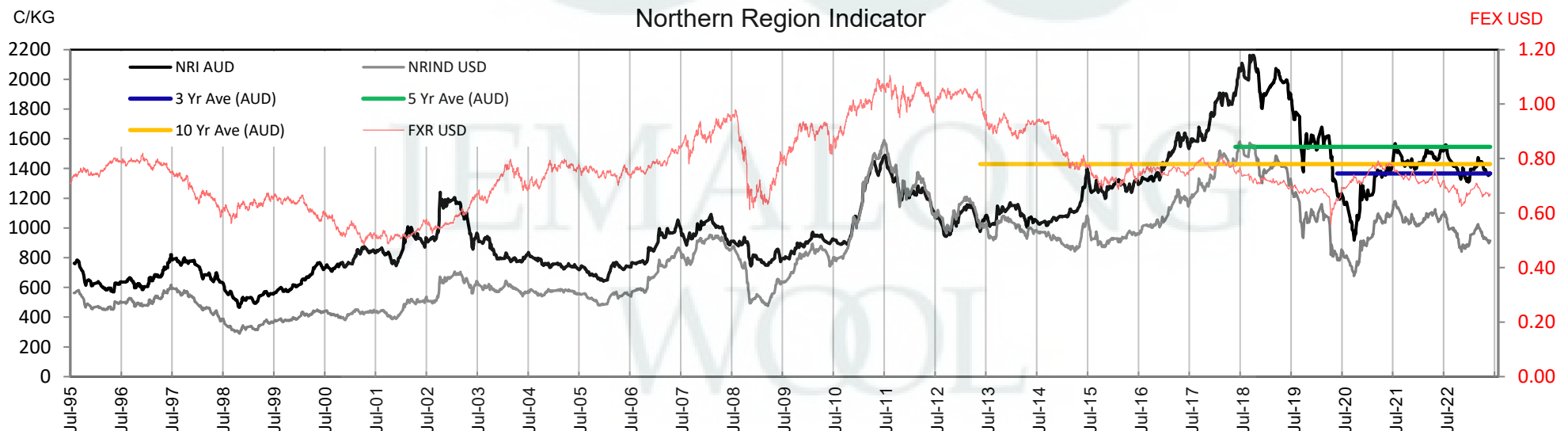

Definitions:

* A Percentile, is a value on a scale of one hundred that indicates the percent of a distribution that is equal to or below it. In general a percentile between 25% and 75% is considered normal, a percentile below 25% is considered below normal and a percentile above 75% is considered above normal.

Three and ten year percentiles shown on the bottom line of table 2 & 3 (above) and in table 1 (on page 1), detail the amount of time during the past 3 & 10 years where the market has traded either at or below its current price.

* Deciles are a method of sorting ranked data into 10 equal groups. The data may be ranked from largest to smallest or vice versa.

The above Decile tables sort price Percentiles into 10 equal groups (in ascending order), with table 2 ranking the previous 3 years prices, while table 3 ranks prices over the previous 10 years.

Example: In Table 2, a Decile Rank of 6 for 19 microns, shows 19 microns have traded at or below 1660 for 60% of the time, over the past three years.

In Table 3, a Decile Rank of 6 for 19 microns, shows 19 microns have traded at or below 1447 for 60% of the time, over the past ten years.

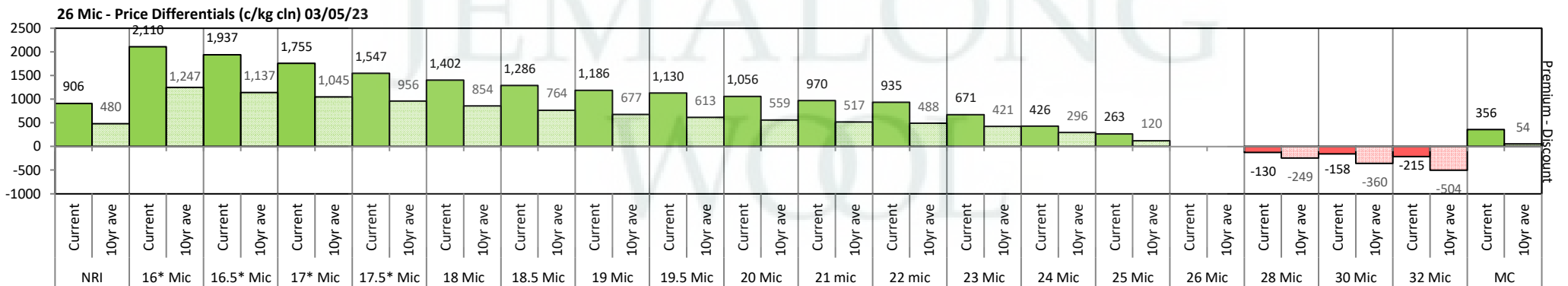


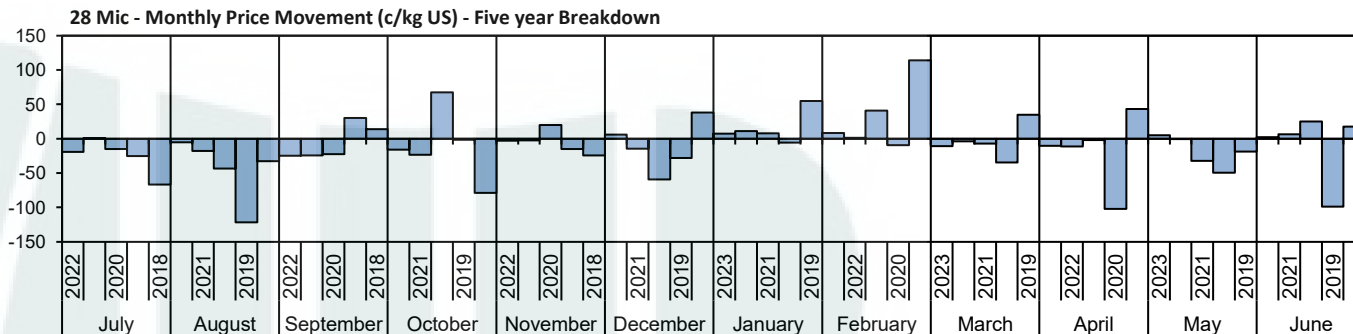
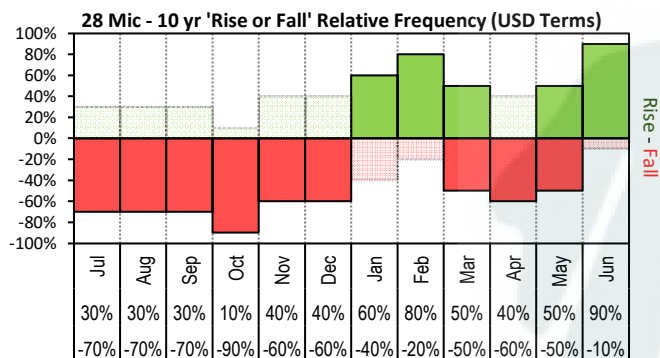


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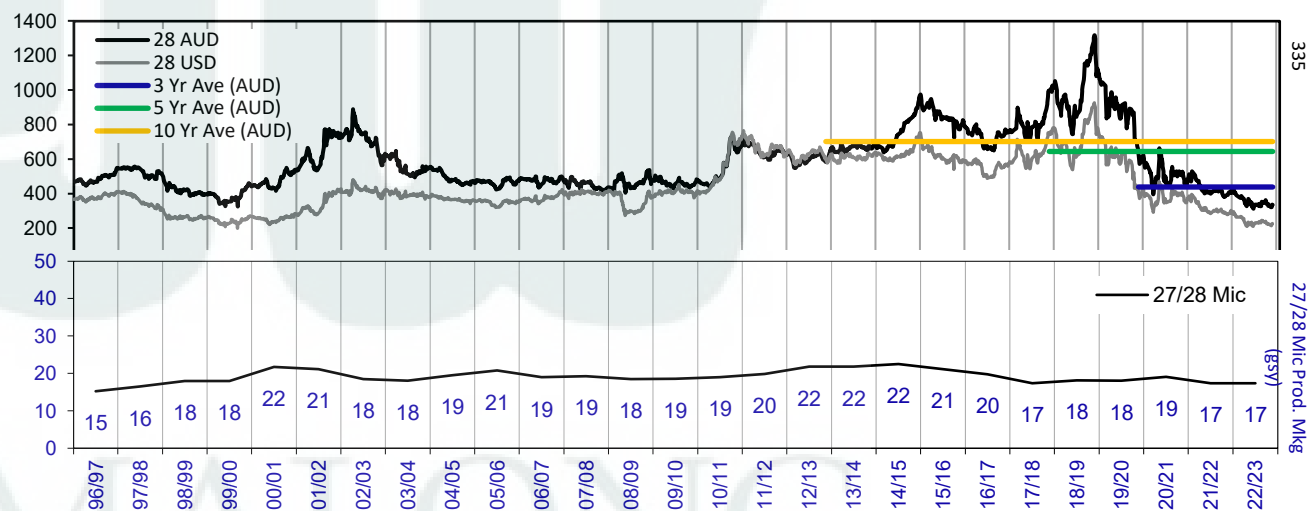
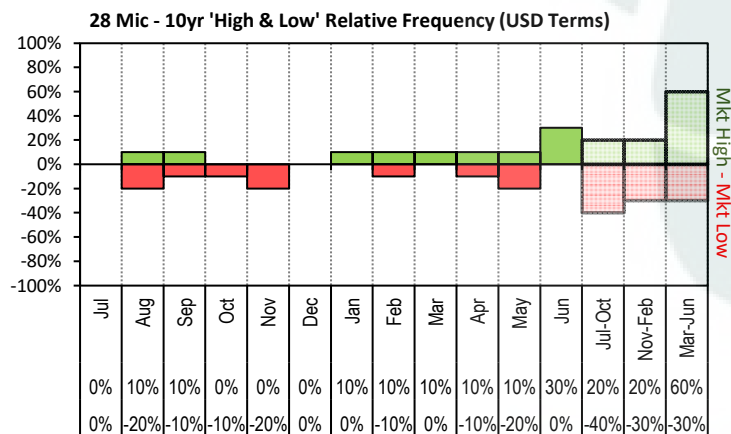


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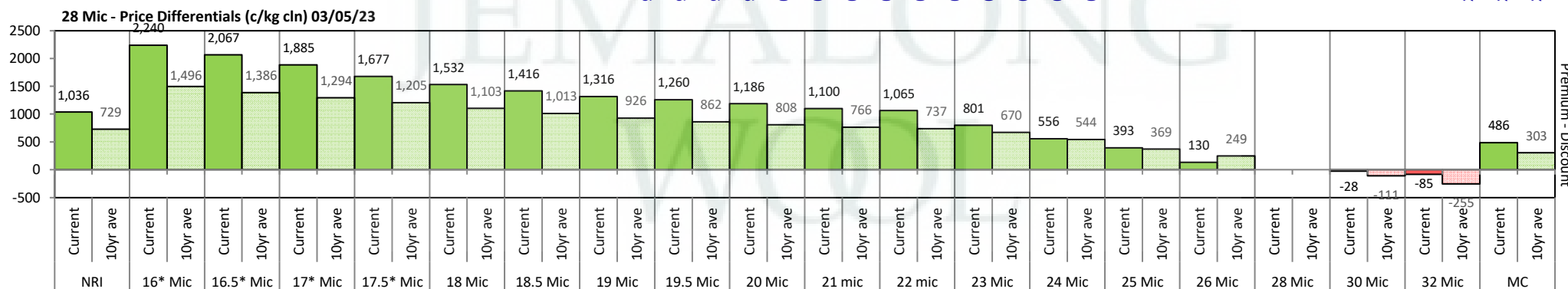


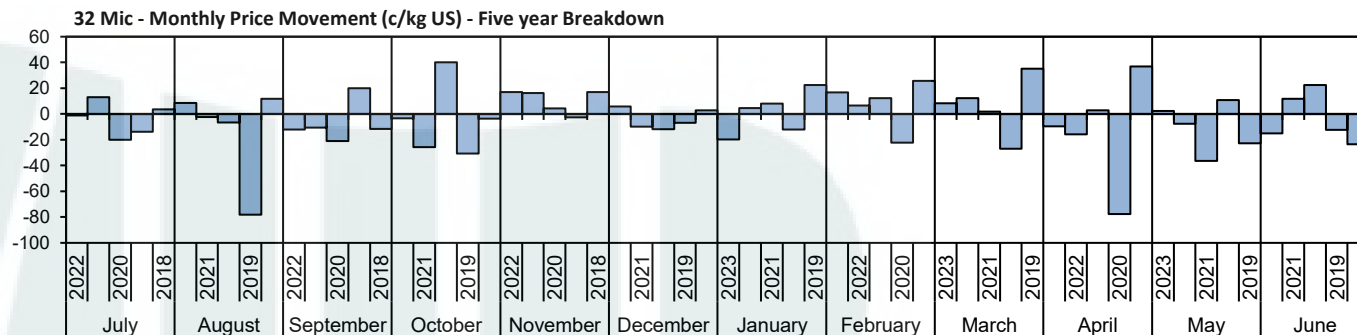
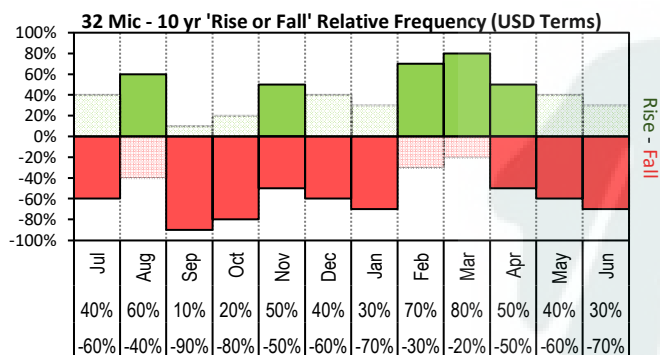


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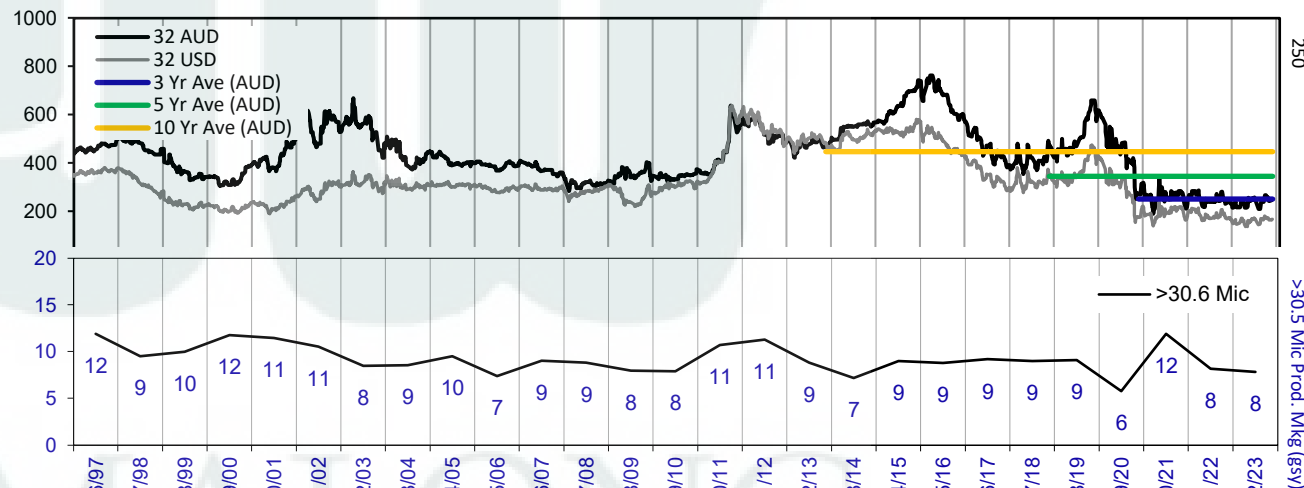
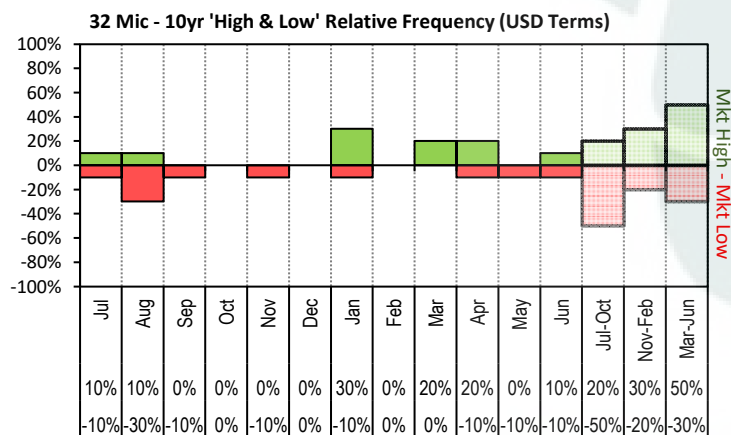


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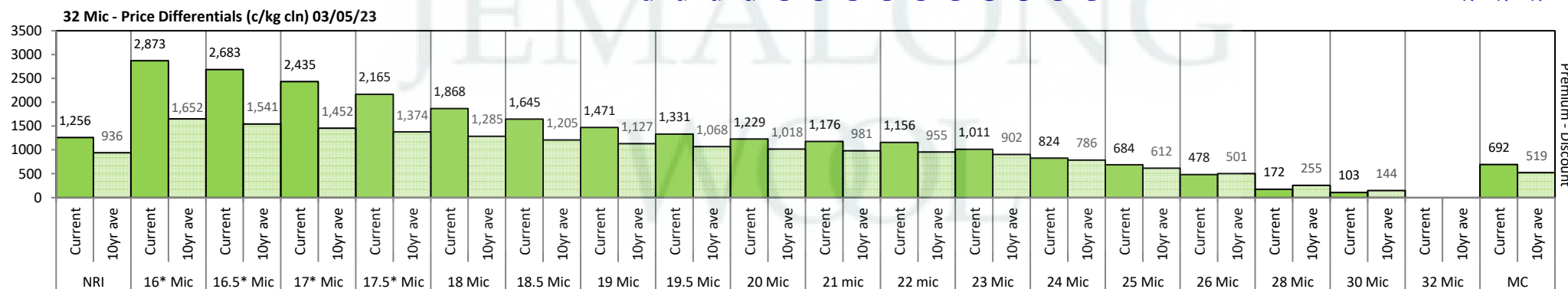


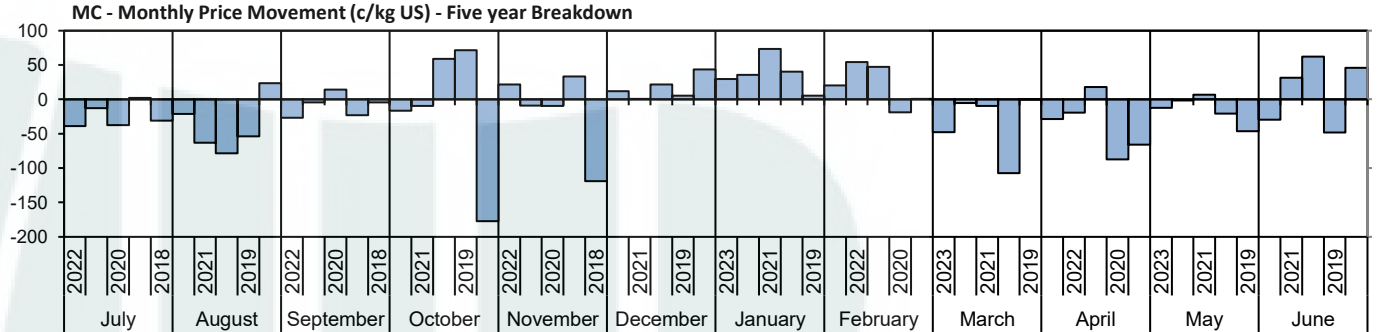
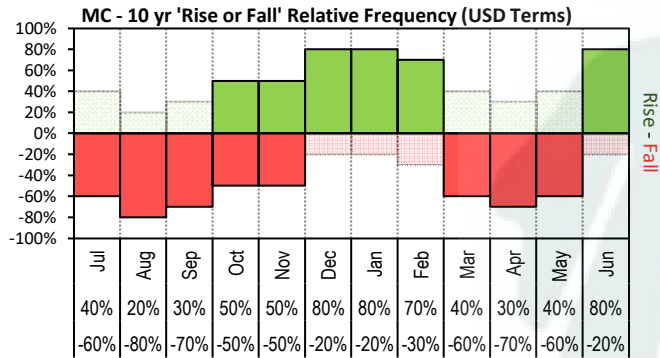


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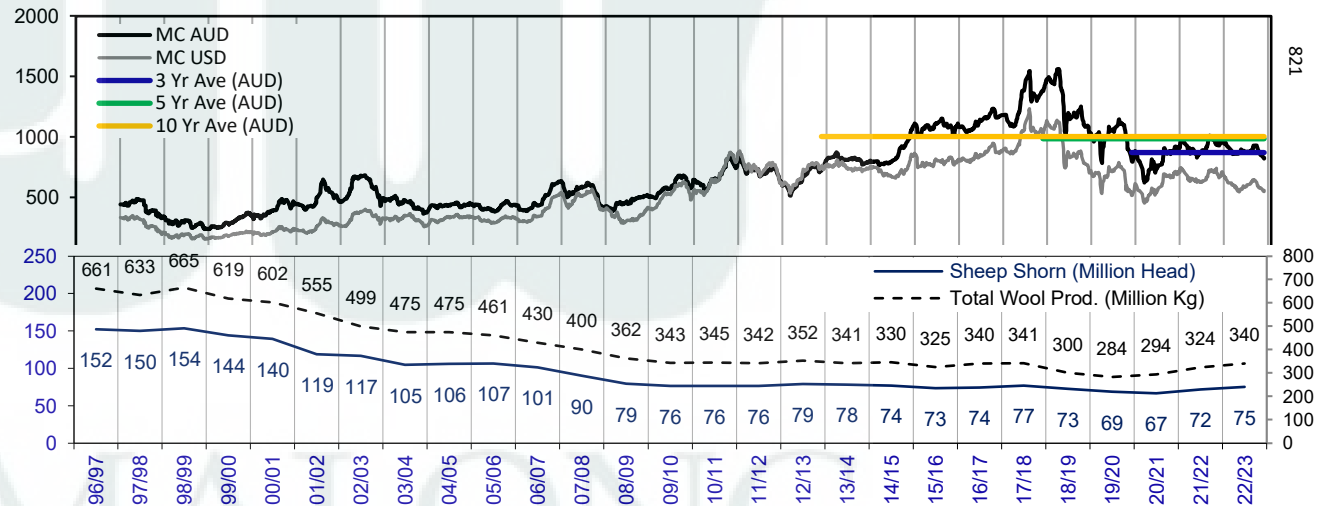
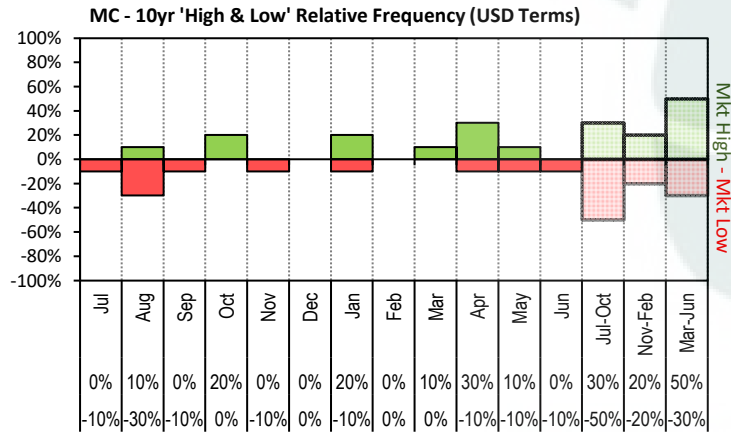


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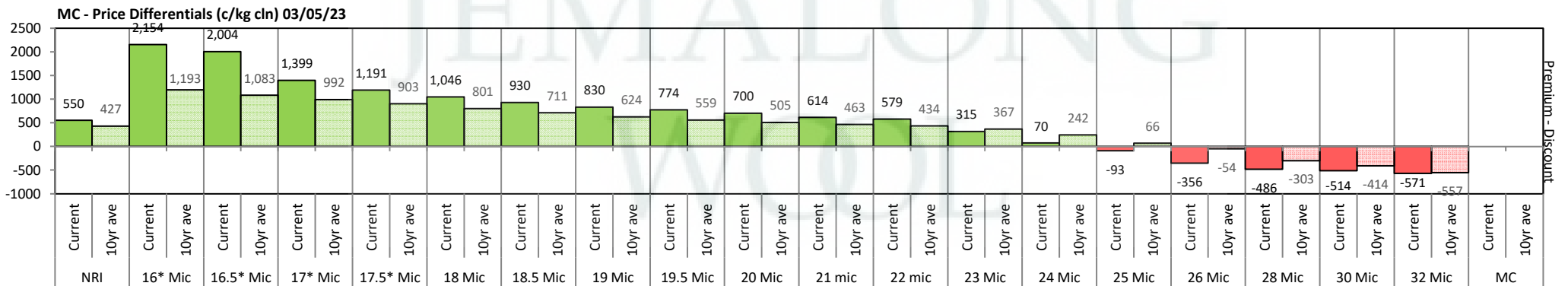




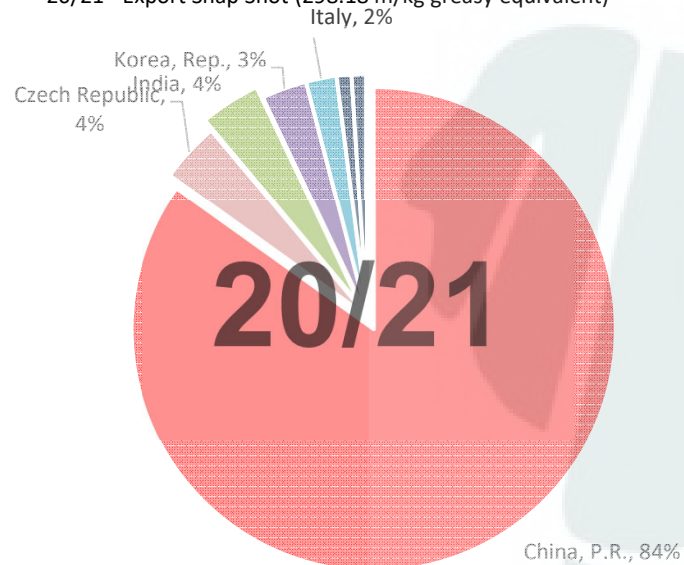
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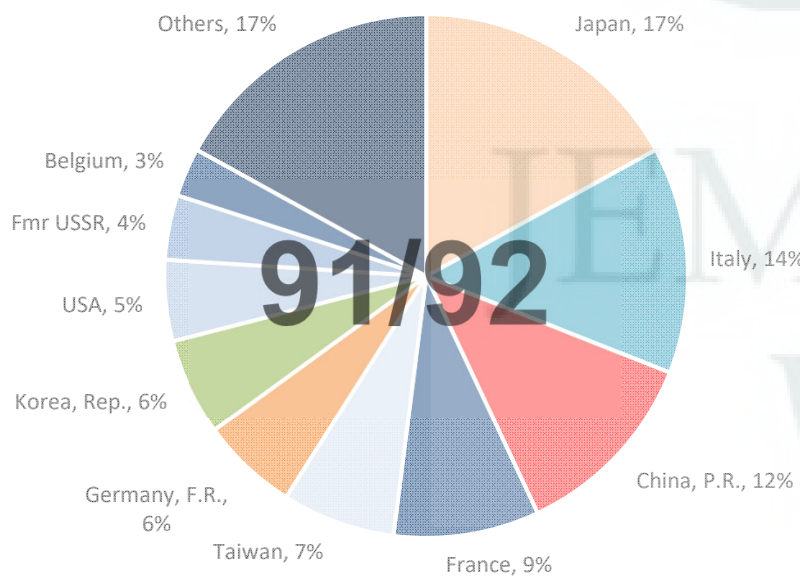
20/21 - Export Snap Shot (298.18 m/kg greasy equivalent)

Seasonal Change m/kg

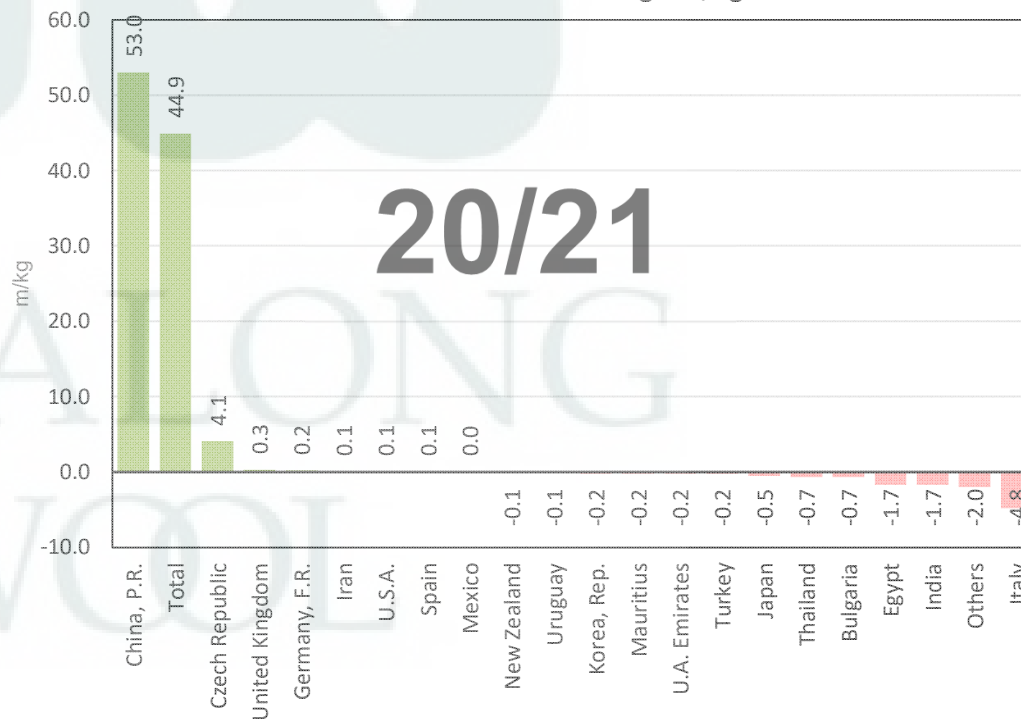
