NORTHERN MARKET REPORT -

Australian Dollar 76.395 US as of 10/08/2006

The first Southern sale after the recess was commenced in Melbourne on Tuesday with 8,078 bales offered (953 or 11.8% were reoffered lots). The market generally opened much cheaper compared to the previous Melb sale. The 17.5 mic fleece erose 22 cents, 18 mic plus 12 cents 18.5 plus 5 cents, 19 to 19.5 mic fell 5 cents, 21 to 23 micron fell 20-22 cents, 24 mic fell 5 cents XB fleece fell 6 to 7 cents. Locks eased slightly while crutchings were up to 10-12 cents cheaper. Passed in rate: 15.8%. Major Buyers: Itochu, Kathaytex, Williams Wool, Modiano, Masurel and Chargeurs

On Wednesday Melbourne had 8,293 bales on offer (415 bales or 5% were reoffered lots). Prices for 17.5 to 19 micron fleeces were slightly easier falling 3 to 6 cents. The 20.0 rose 7 cents, 21 micron rose 11 cents, 22 mic rose 3 cents and 24-26 mic fell 3 to 5 cents. The crossbreds also remained unchanged. Merino skirtings closed firm while oddments 10-15 cents firmer. Passed in rate: 16.2%. Major Buyers: Itochu, Kathaytex, Fox & Lillie, Techwool BWK Elders and Startoy

Melbourne had 10,441 bales offered on Thursday with 9% or 940 reoffered bales. The market opened firm with the only real gain recorded in the 20 mic fleece. 17.5 mic fell 3 cents. XB fleece eased slightly on a limited offering. Locks eased slightly and crutchings were unchanged. Passed in rate: 10.0%. Major Buyers: Itochu, Modiano, BWK Elders, Techwool, Chargeurs and Quality Wool

The Sydney on Wednesday had 8,384 bales offered (1,218 or 14.6% were reoffered lots). The market opened firm with much most microns closing on a similar note. The exception was the 17.5 micron fleece which rose 28 cents. The finer more stylish skirts from 18.5 to 21 mic rose 5-10 cents. XB fleece stayed firm. Locks and crutchings also closed firm. Passed in rate: 7.7%. Major Buyers: BWK Elders, Techwool, Southern Cross, Chargeurs & Modiano

On Thursday the Sydney market closed with mixed results. There were 8647 bales on offer (813 bales or 8.4% were reoffered lots). Prices for 17.0 and 18.0 mic fleece rose 4 cents, 20-21 mic rose 1 cent and 26 mic fell 4 cents. The crossbreds also remained unchanged. Merino skirtings closed firm while oddments were slightly firmer. Passed in rate: 16.2%. Major Buyers: BWK Elders, Techwool, Modiano, Williams Wool & Chargeurs

In Fremantle on Wednesday there were 5,632 bales offered (783 bales or 13.9% were reoffered lots). The market opened firm and closed with 18.5 to 20 mic rising slightly, the 21 mic rising 7 cents and 22 mic rising 2 cents. The finer skirts were slightly firmer and the 20 to 22 mic skirts rose by up 2 cents. Lambs, locks and crutching all closed firm. Passed in rate: 10.5% Major Buyers: BWK Elders, PJ Morris, Modiano, Itochu, Michell & H Dawson

Fremantle on Thursday had 4,438 bales offered (772 bales or 17.4% were reoffered lots). The market opened firm with 19 micron fleeces falling slightly, and the 20, 22-23 mic fleeces rising slightly. The finer skirts were slightly dearer with others unchanged. Lambs were unchanged, washing locks were firm, carbo locks 5-6 cents firmer. Crutchings were slightly dearer. Passed in rate: 17.0%. Major Buyers: BWK Elders, Modiano, PJ Morris, Itochu, Kathaytex & Dewavrin

Next Week: There are two day sales in all centres with 50,625 bales rostered nationally.







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
