The negative mood of the closing auction sales before the Easter recess continued throughout the break and early this week with the resumption of sales. Sales throughout the break were limited with buyers not willing to meet the price levels of the close. With reduced demand and larger offerings scheduled for April, futures prices declined last week by up to 35c/kg for the near months. The auction market opened on Tuesday in all centres with cheaper prices quoted (20-35c/kg) mirroring the falls in the futures market the week before. After the considerable falls posted on Tuesday, the market steadied on Wednesday closing 2-5c/kg clean dearer for most micron categories. Prices on Thursday continued to strengthen recovering some of the losses made on Tuesday. Prices closed 2.5% cheaper for the week for fleece wools, 1% cheaper for skirtings and 0.5% cheaper for the cardings. Some Chinese demand returned in the market this week for fine wools on Wooltrade, this being the first real interest in 18.5micron for some weeks. Other demand on Thursday was seen for crossbred fleece and 20.5micron tenders.

Declining wool futures quoted throughout the break set the pace for the market opening this week. Despite the negative mood on Tuesday however, Macquarie Wool Futures reported increased buying interest in spring with months Aug-Oct 21-23 micron prices strengthening. Demand was seen again in the futures market on Thursday morning with levels for June and July -02 strengthening by up to 20c/kg clean. Some growers Good Till Cancelled Orders were filled for June-July at around 935-945c/kg clean for 21-23 micron.

Sales continue next week with offerings of 85,000 bales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle.
