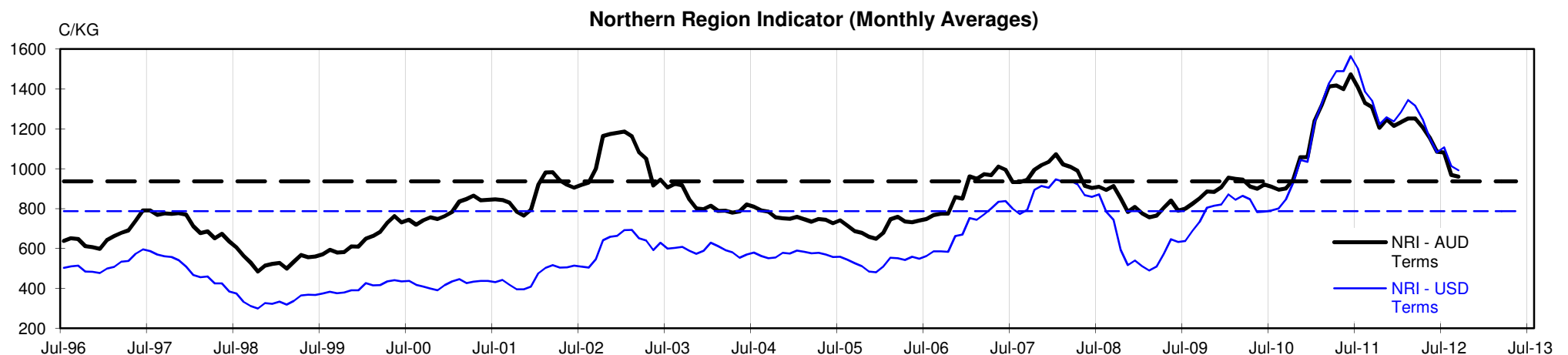
MARKET COMMENTARY

NORTHERN REGION –Sale Week 11/12 (36,226 bales offered nationally)

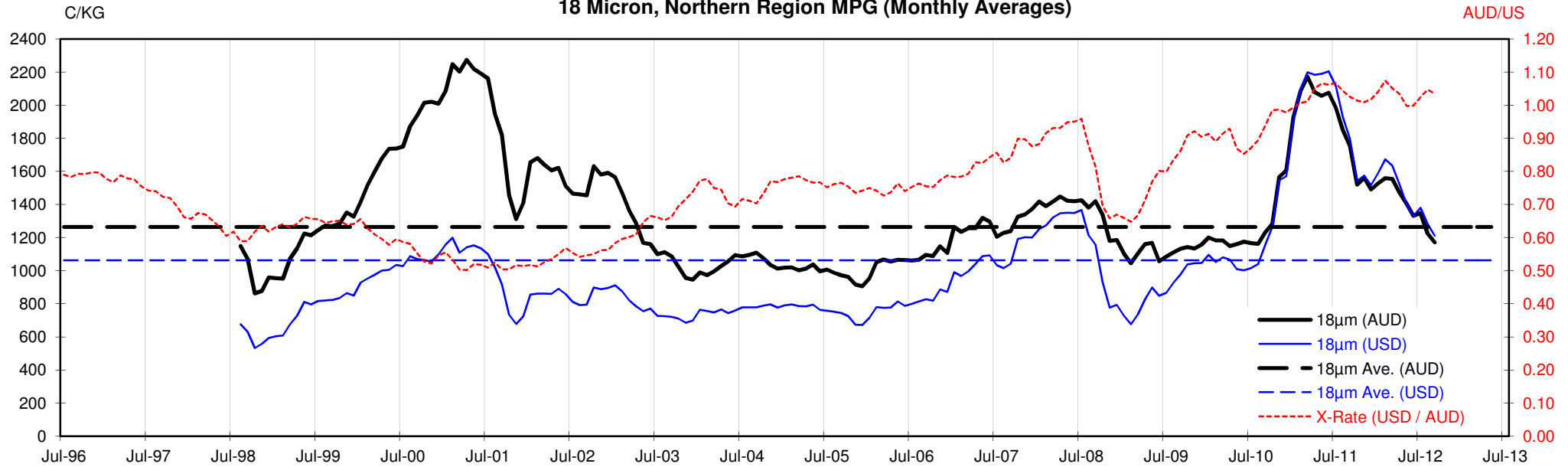
Wednesdays market saw the much anticipated turn around finally arrive as buyers pushed the market higher on the back of possible shipping commitments for this month. 19 to 21 microns made significant increases of 40-50 cents while the finer range of 17 to 18.5 microns rose by 30 cents. The limited offering of 16.5 microns left this area unchanged on a nominal basis. Merino skirtings also gained ground by 20-30 cents, with the 8% Vm lots most affected and the lower Vm types (<3%) less affected. Oddments enjoyed similar gains to the rest of the market, with locks & stains 20 cents dearer, while crutchings remained unchanged on a limited selection. Crossbreds resisted the trend upwards, remaining fully firm for most microns, while 28 microns closed a little dearer by 5 cents. 5.8% Passed-In.

Thursdays market saw the finer end lift while the broader microns eased. 18.5 microns and finer increased by around 10 cents on the back of solid support for the better style & strength types, while 16.5 microns gained over 20 cents. The medium microns were firm to slightly dearer while 20 micron and broader eased 5-10 cents. Merino skirtings remained solid for all descriptions with the focus on the 19 to 20 micron range, which rose 20 cents for the 4% to 8% Vm lots. Locks remained firm while crutchings were rose 20 cents and stains improved by 10. In the crossbreds, 27 to 30 micron ended the day fully firm on a limited offering, while a limited selection of 32 microns posted 15-20 cent increases . 2.3% PI

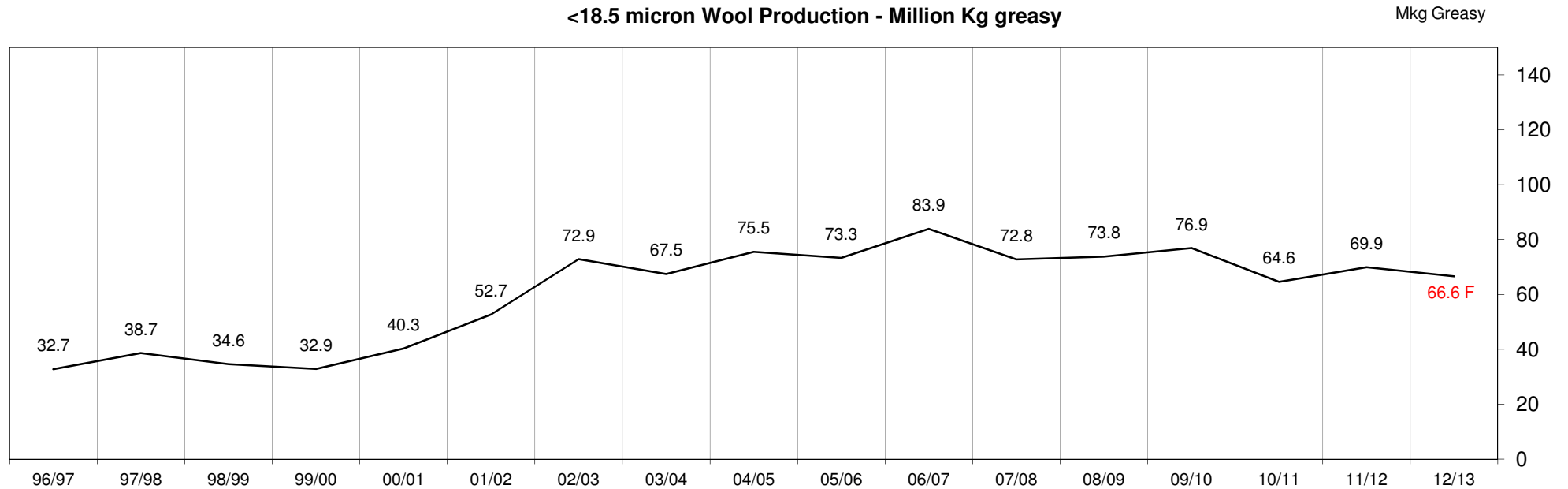


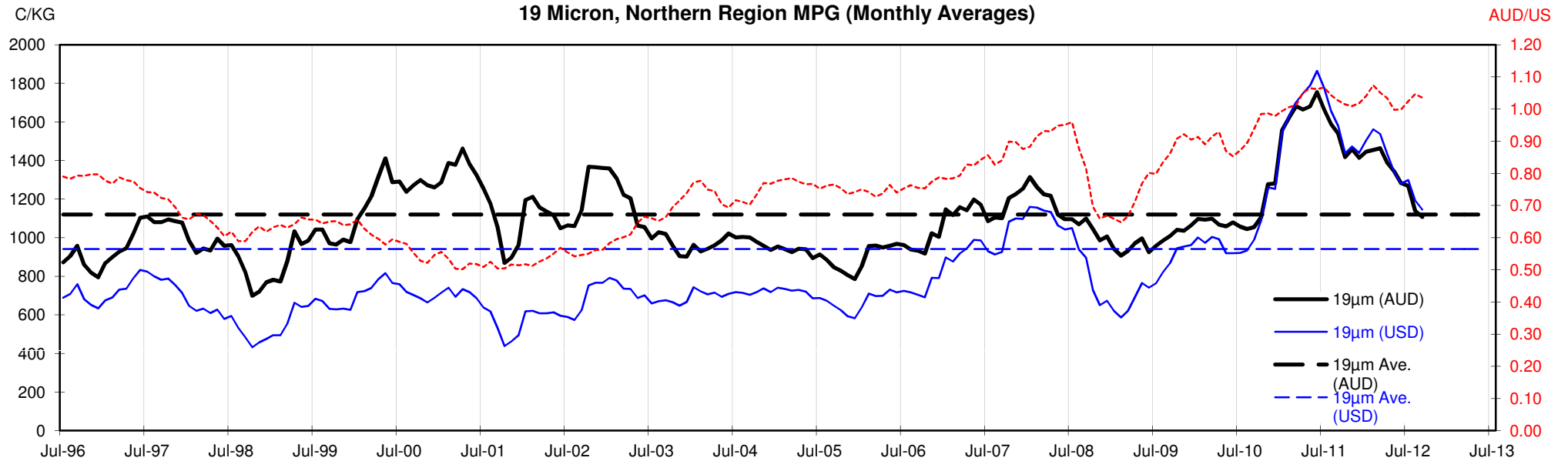


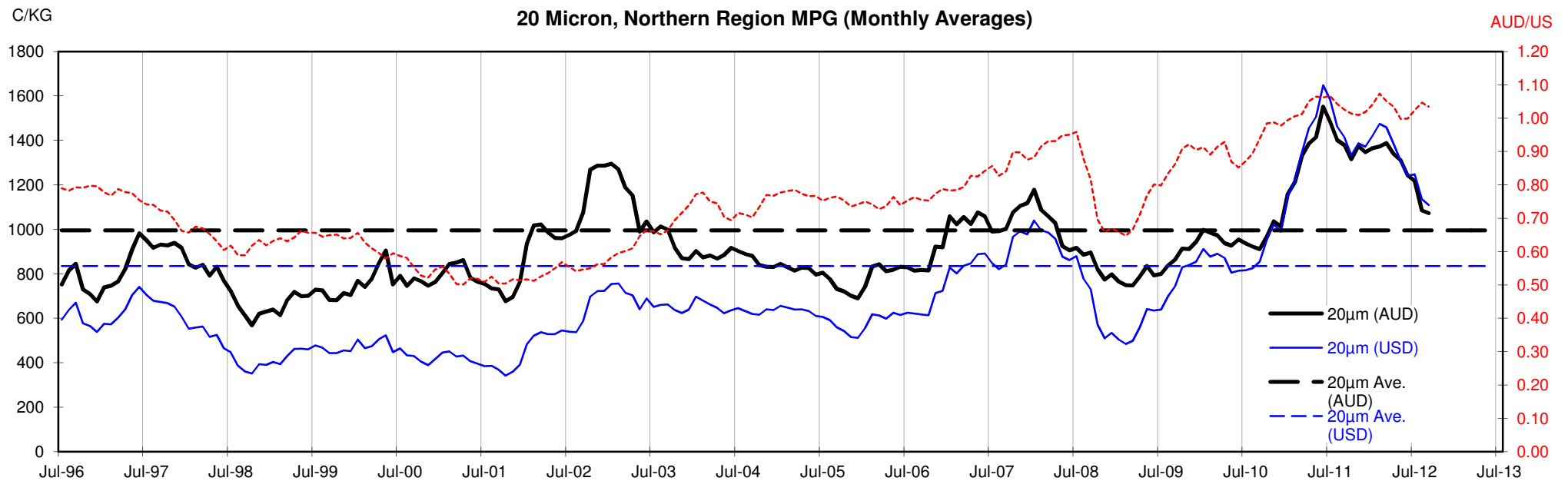
18 Micron, Northern Region MPG (Monthly Averages)

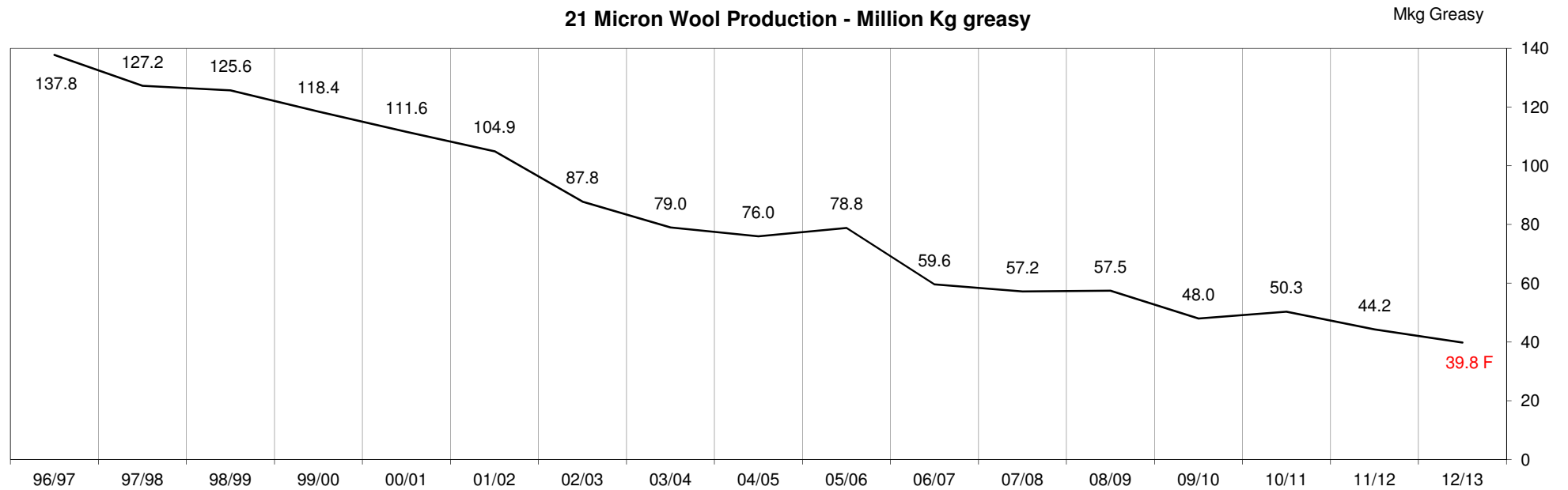
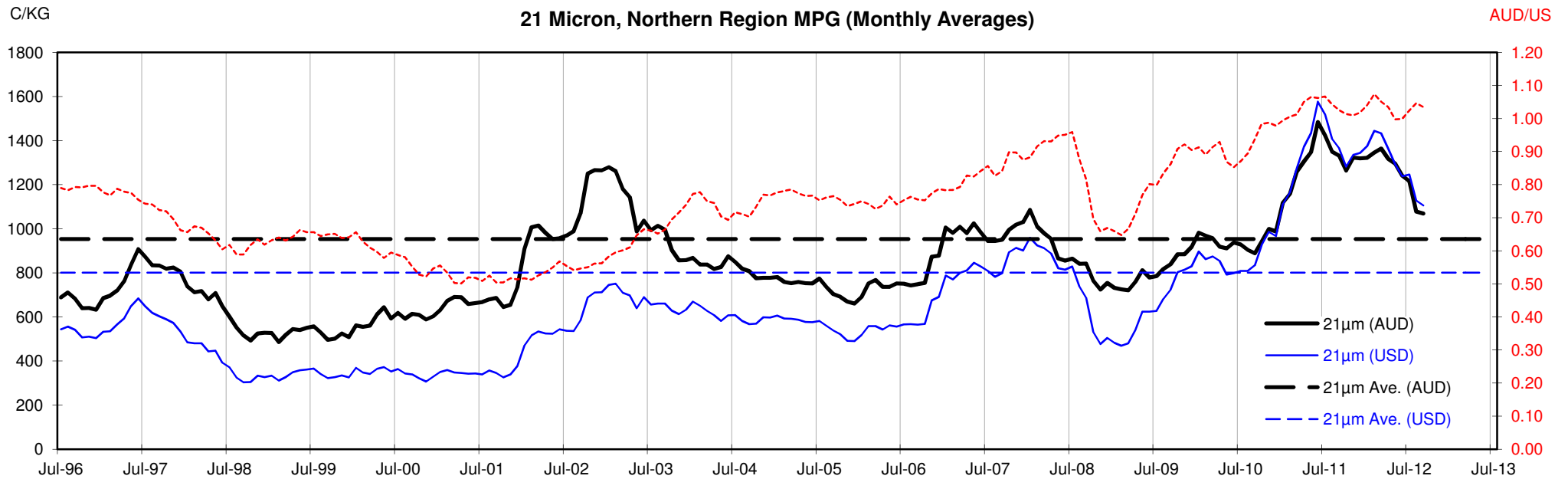


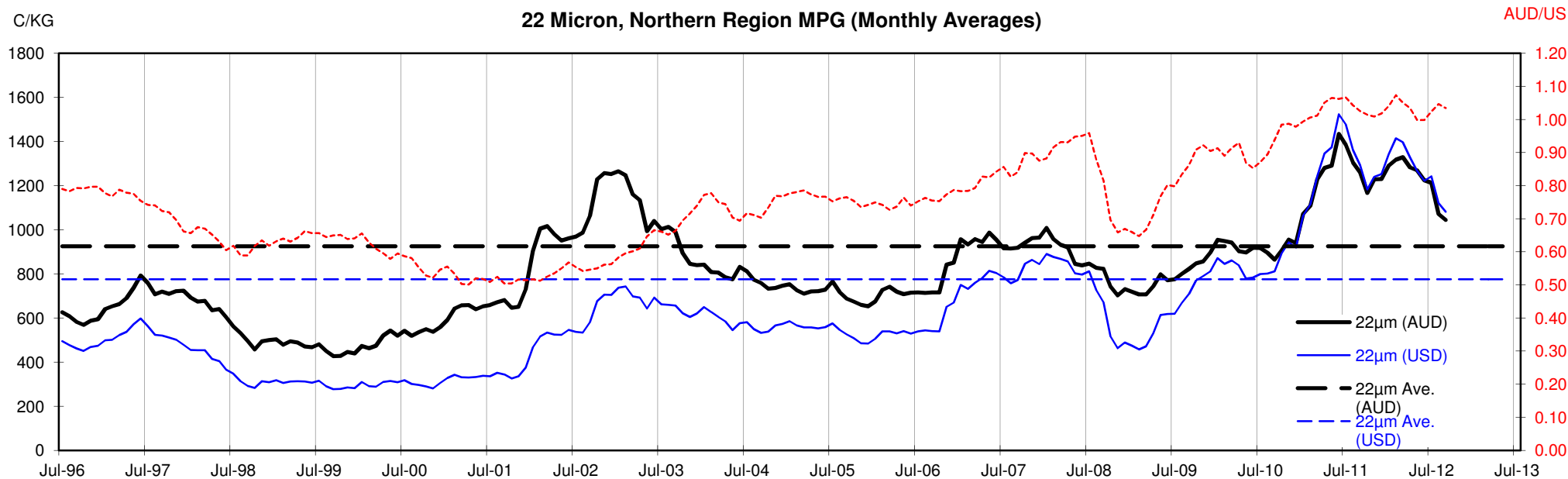
<18.5 micron Wool Production - Million Kg greasy

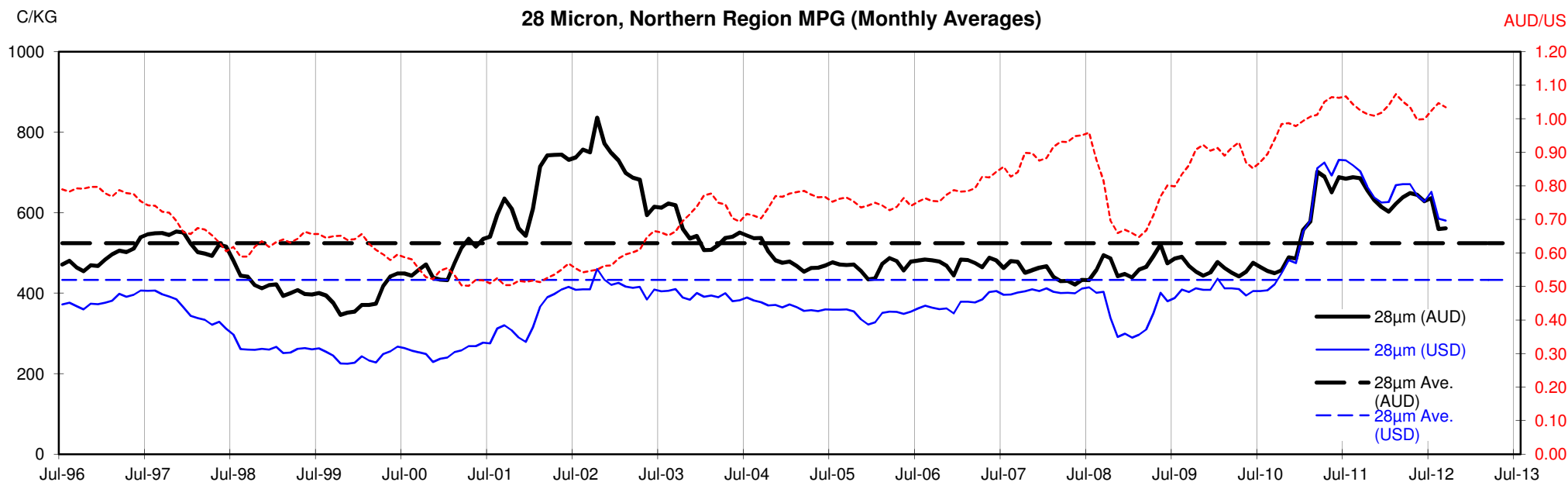




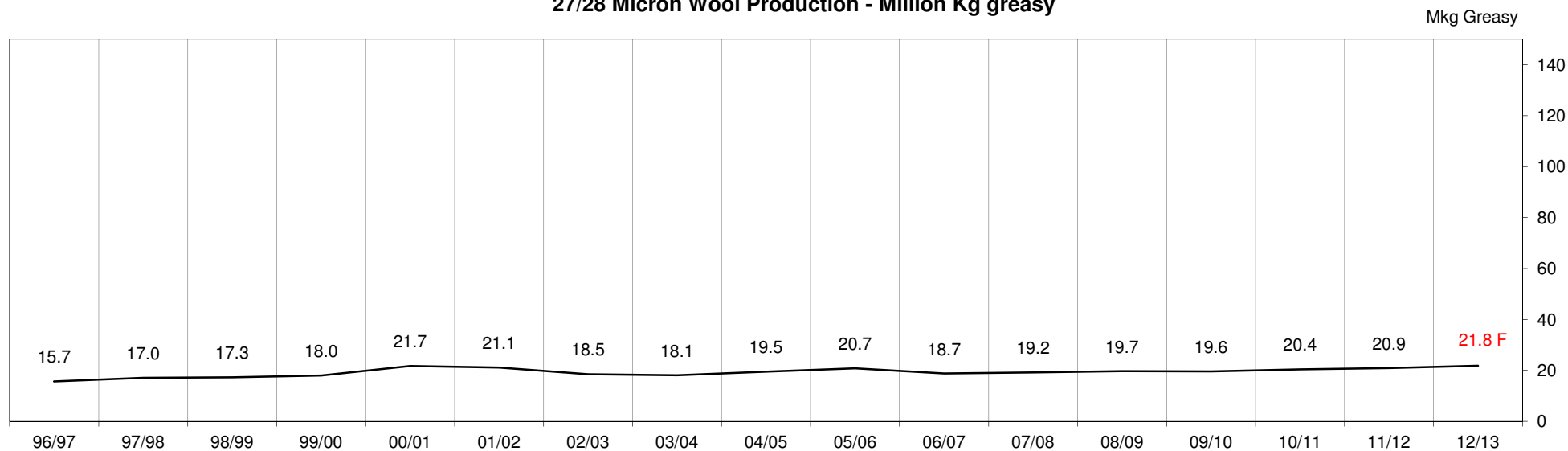








27/28 Micron Wool Production - Million Kg greasy



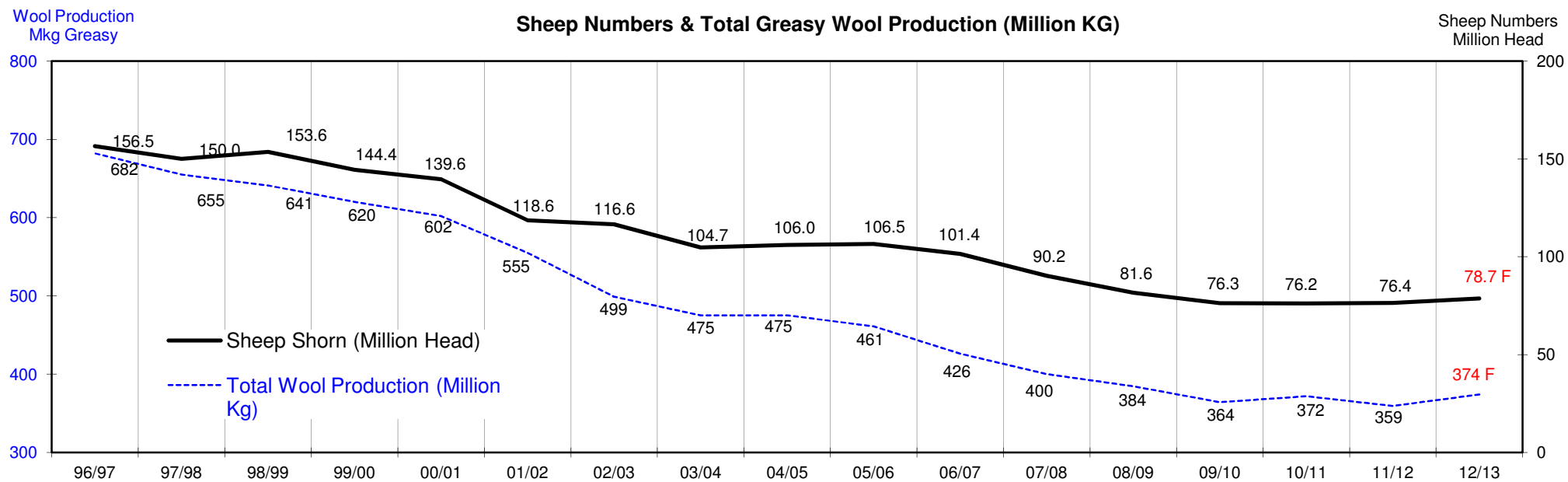
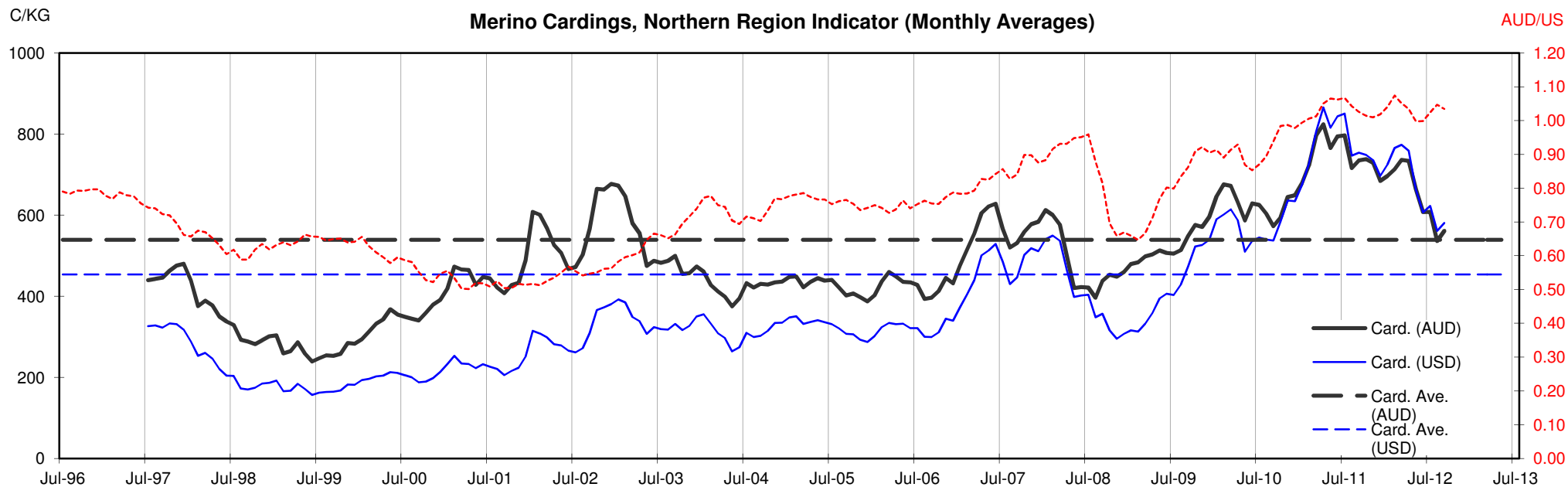
