NORTHERN MARKET REPORT

Sales were held in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week. The national offering was slightly larger this week with approximately 61,500 bales in auction sales.

Sales opened with a small offering in Sydney on Tuseday, and comparisons were difficult to last week's sale in Newcastle. Generally there small positive movements in prices for 20 micron and broader fleeces, but there were falls for 18 microns which closed 5c/kg clean cheaper.


The Australian dollar continued to rise this week and it pushed through 77c US on Wednesday. The market has shown reilience against a rising dollar in recently, however the market finally reacted on Wednesday. Prices fell around 10-15c/kg clean for all fleece wools 20 micron and finer, while the broader end remained generally unchanged. Crossbreds and merino skirtings were generally unchanged.

Early on Thursday morning the dollar rose above 78c US which helped prices ease further in sales on Thursday. Prices for 22 micron and finer fell around 15c/kg clean. The broader end and crossbreds were less affected, falling very slightlyly. Merino skirtings also fell heavily on Thursday, with prices finishing 10c/kg clean lower. Oddments finished the week generally unchanged.

The graph below illustrates the effect the rising dollar has had on prices paid for wool in \$USD terms. Between the end of September and the close of sales on Thursday the Southern 21 MPG remained unchanged at 773c/kg in Australian dollars. However, over the same period the 21 MPG has risen from 553c/kg to 611c/kg in \$USD, which represents a rise of 10.5%. The short-term outlook for wool prices is bleak with commentators forecasting the dollar to push towards 80c US. Without a strong underlying demand the market continues to be influenced by the higher dollar.

Next week sales continue in Sydnety, Melbourne and Fremantle.


