Wool prices were weaker again this week, but the falls this week were moderate in comparison to recent weeks. On Wednesday prices were generally down 10-23 c/kg clean for merino fleece wools. 18.5 micron fleece wools rose 1 c/kg clean. As has been the recent trend better types of fleece wool >40nkt were not as affected by price falls as were fleece wools with <40 nkt. Merino skirtings were unchanged while crossbreds were both generally slightly cheaper. The passed in rate for Wednesday was 27.2%.

On Thursday for 18 micron merino fleece wools prices were slightly firmer up 5 c/kg clean. For all other merino fleece wools prices generally fell between 5-14 c/kg clean. Again better styles of fleece wools were unchanged to slightly dearer. On Thursday skirtings were slightly firmer, crossbreds were up to 2.5% cheaper and oddments were around 2% dearer. The passed-in rate for Thursday was 26.8%, much lower for this week than in the previous few weeks.


The Macquarie Wool Futures fell heavily on Monday but on Tuesday rose sharply to finish higher than Friday's closing quotes. Wednesday futures prices were up a further 10 c/kg clean.

The national offering for the week was 37,500 bales with around 25,500 bales being sold nationally this week.

Sales continue next week in Fremantle, Sydney and Melbourne.

Figure 1: Northern MPG Movement




