
### MARKET COMMENTARY

With only Sydney & Melbourne selling this week, the offering was reduced to a mere 26,799 bales. Despite the low volume offering, the market was only just maintained, with the Northern and Southern Region indicators closing only slightly dearer, up 4 and 5 cents respectively. The better style finer microns were well supported while the medium to broader microns eased slightly before a late rally on Thursday. Mid break was once again a strong focus in the fleece categories, with significant discounts for the higher mid break lots.

Merino skirtings and oddments were well supported on both days and astonishingly the Merino Carding Indicator continued its record price run, gaining a further 15 cent to close 57% above the 10 year average (the dearest it has been since recording commenced in 1997). The crossbred market was largely unchanged, after easing slightly on Wednesday and firming on Thursday.

Next week will see the first designated "Australian Superfine" sale take place for the season. The sale will be held in Sydney following the closure of the Newcastle facility in February. An improved selection of super fine wools will hopefully help the finer end of the market. however the overall larger volumes coming onto the market in the next few weeks, could easily put downward pressure on price until demand picks up.

Looking ahead, while China's domestic demand is levelling out, economic growth and consumer confidence in other major wool consuming counties is expected to improve in the second half of 2013 and into 2014. As world wool production remains at long term lows, if demand does improve and unused processing capacity comes online a very strong market should ensue. However before any significant improvement in price can occur, reported stocks of processed wool will need to be cleared.

### **Decile Tables** are a useful tool for working out price targets.

Percentiles are a more accurate guide to where the market is currently trading (The higher the percentile, the stronger the market).

### Definitions:

- \* A Percentile, is a value on a scale of one hundred that indicates the percent of a distribution that is equal to or below it. In general a percentile between 25% and 75% is considered normal, a percentile below 25% is considered below normal and a percentile above 75% is considered above normal.
- Three and ten year percentiles shown on the bottom line of table 2 & 3 (above) and in table 1 (on page 1), detail the amount of time during the past 3 & 10 years where the market has traded either at or below its current price.
- \* Deciles are a method of sorting ranked data into 10 equal groups. The data may be ranked from largest to smallest or vice versa.

The above Decile tables sort price Percentiles into 10 equal groups (in ascending order), with table 2 ranking the previous 3 years prices, while table 3 ranks prices over the previous 10 year <a href="Example: Example: Example: "Example: In Table 2, a Decile Rank of 6 for 19 microns, shows 19 microns have traded at or below 1408 for 60% of the time, over the past three years."

In Table 3, a Decile Rank of 6 for 19 microns, shows 19 microns have traded at or below 1102 for 60% of the time, over the past ten years.
