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MARKET COMMENTARY Source: AWI

Price gains on all Merino types and descriptions was the primary reason for the overall lift in this week's market. Despite adverse movements in the exchange rate, the Merino sector gained 20-60 cents for the week.

The increased buying pressure from China pushed the market into higher territory initially; however, other global wool destinations were also placing small orders. The locally based traders and largest exporters led the buyers' purchase list this week, but the price gains came from the strength of the competing indents. As prices opened dearer, the offshore users lifted their bids to match the rises.

The third largest of the Chinese top makers continues to overshadow the current buying of the usually dominant two topmakers, which has been the case for several weeks, as many government uniform orders have reportedly flowed to that factory.

Over 49,000 bales are rostered for sale next week in the last designated superfine sale until February 2024. There are only three weeks of auctions before the annual three-week Christmas recess.

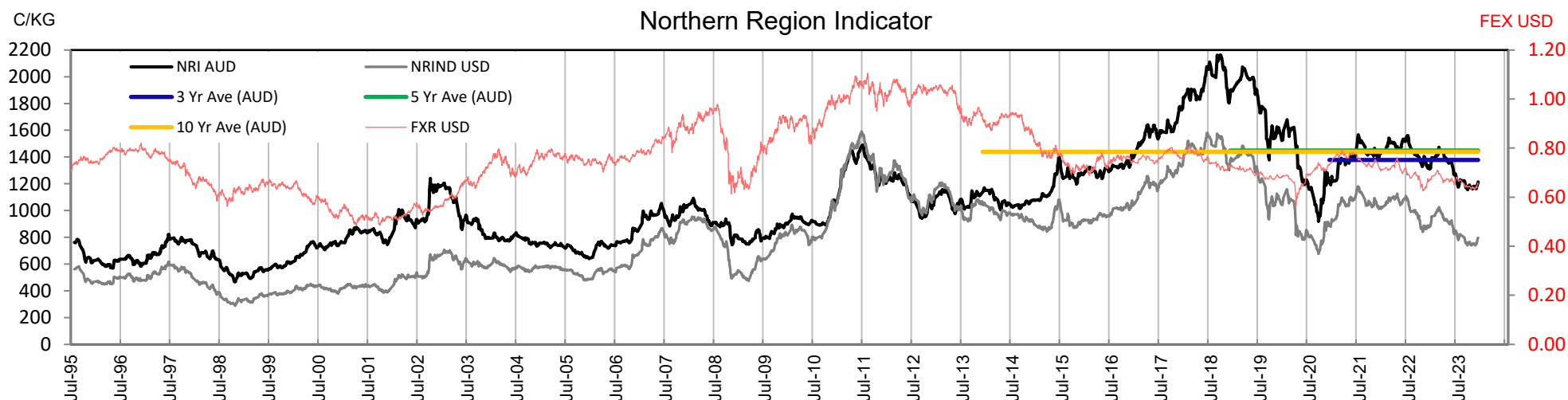

Definitions:

* A Percentile, is a value on a scale of one hundred that indicates the percent of a distribution that is equal to or below it. In general a percentile between 25% and 75% is considered normal, a percentile below 25% is considered below normal and a percentile above 75% is considered above normal.

Three and ten year percentiles shown on the bottom line of table 2 & 3 (above) and in table 1 (on page 1), detail the amount of time during the past 3 & 10 years where the market has traded either at or below its current price.

* Deciles are a method of sorting ranked data into 10 equal groups. The data may be ranked from largest to smallest or vice versa.

The above Decile tables sort price Percentiles into 10 equal groups (in ascending order), with table 2 ranking the previous 3 years prices, while table 3 ranks prices over the previous 10 years.

Example: In Table 2, a Decile Rank of 6 for 19 microns, shows 19 microns have traded at or below 1656 for 60% of the time, over the past three years.

In Table 3, a Decile Rank of 6 for 19 microns, shows 19 microns have traded at or below 1464 for 60% of the time, over the past ten years.
